Secretary's Report

Next year we are doing away with the 90 hound maximum, but to do this we must start at 10.am, to achieve this you will need to be **registered by 9.30am.**

We will introduce a **record book** for each hound that is entered in 2008, this will record any LCM points scored plus will include the KC name, registration number, breed and colour with space for a photograph of the hound if you wish to include. Any points for LCM will be put in by Official of the BSFA, all points won already will be put in. All this will be done with your membership which is due 1st January 2008, unless you joined on the last meeting, please let me know that you will be running your hound in 2008 so that you will receive your record book, before the meeting.

All **memberships** to be sent to me at 4 Church Lane , West Parley, Dorset, BH22 8TS. Your **entries for the meeting** will go to Tracy Chamberlaine, who is Acting Secretary with me for the next year. Please note her address is 62 Vandyke, Bracknell, Berkshire RG12 8UR.

The charges will be the same:

£7.50 for membership, £1 to register a new hound, £4.50 for 1st hound entered and £3.50 for all subsequent entries.

Classes to stay the same:

Class 1 Yearling 12months to 23 months; **Class 2 Intermediate** 2 years to 3 years; **Class 3 Open** any age over 4 years; **Class 4 Veteran** 7 years and over.
